Under this theme, children will learn how God fed His people in His grace from the Bible. As God provided with their physical needs, we can see God's provision, providence and love for His people.

So, the adults will share the word of God with the same theme and passages that our children will share during the VBS. I hope you can have a chance to talk about the theme and the Bible stories with the children of our church in July. Please pray for our precious children, for Sunday School teachers and the volunteers to grow together, for their safety and that they have fun!
