But even after Romans changed the calendar to twelve months and October became tenth month, the month's name was stuck.

When John Wesley and his friends formed "Holy Club" in Oxford University, people laughed at their <u>methodical</u> way of life. But that stuck as the name of the movement. That's why we are called "Methodist" ever since.



The question will be "Did you actually follow Jesus?" Did we really tried to act like Jesus, to talk like Him, or think like Him? Have we followed His footsteps to grow every day?
